Inaugural Annual Report of National Security and Intelligence Committee of Parliamentarians to be tabled

OTTAWA – The 2018 Annual Report of the National Security and Intelligence Committee of Parliamentarians (NSICOP) will be tabled in Parliament today.

The report contains the findings and recommendations of two extensive committee reviews completed in 2018:

- the first external review of the intelligence activities of the Department of National Defence and the Canadian Armed Forces; and
- a review of the complex mechanisms used by Government to establish the core intelligence priorities that frame Canada's national security posture.

The Committee delivered a classified version of the report to the Prime Minister on December 21, 2018. The public version of the Annual Report is expected to be tabled at approximately 10 a.m. After tabling, copies of the report will be available through the parliamentary press gallery and at <u>http://www.nsicop-cpsnr.ca/index-en.html</u>.

The Chair of NSICOP, the Hon. David McGuinty, will deliver remarks on the report during a 11:15 a.m. news conference. A Q&A session with Parliamentary Press Gallery members will follow at the National Press Theatre.
